LEARNING METHODS

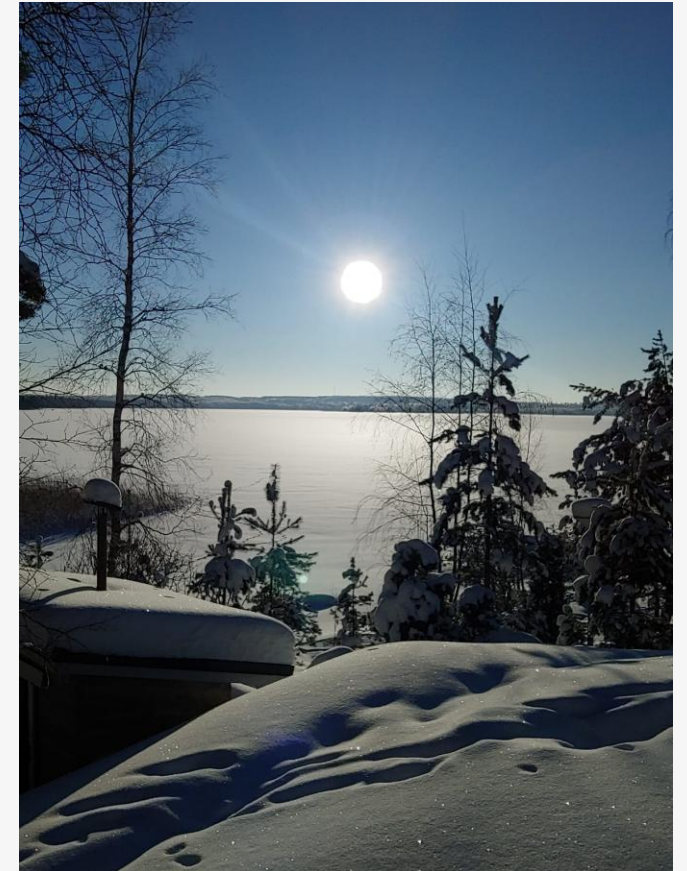
- The learning approach will include lectures, excursions, visits to companies, and project work in interdisciplinary and international teams
