Application periods



- Student exchange (and placements abroad via LAB partner institution):
 - Autumn 2026/Spring 2027 (also Double Degree) → main application period 19.1.-29.1.2026
 - Spring 2027 (places that are still available) → 20.4.-4.5.2026 (supplementary application period)
 - Thinking about exchange in spring 2027 but not sure yet? → Better to apply in supplementary application
 - Note! No application periods during the autumn semester anymore!
- *Self-obtained placements abroad (grant application)*
 - *you look for placement/internship yourself*
 - *No specific application period - you can apply for the grant once placement is confirmed*
 - *Instructions in eLAB (Completing studies → Internationalization and student exchange → Placement abroad)*

Small Exchange Dictionary



- Mobility-Online System = exchange / mobility application system used at LAB
- Home Institution/ Sending Institution = LAB University of Applied Sciences
- Host Institution/ Receiving Institution
= the school where you are going to study abroad
- Student exchange contact person at LAB
= Miiia Tuominen (email outgoing@lab.fi)
- Responsible person in home/sending institution
= your LAB Departmental Coordinator (informed later in the slides)
- LA – Learning Agreement = study agreement and credit transfer plan between you, LAB and host institution
- ECTS= European Credit Transfer System, 1 ECTS = 1 LAB credit/opintopiste
- Grant: Special funding for your exchange period
- Grant programme: Erasmus+/Nordplus/Bilateral/ Swiss mobility
- Nomination: informing the selected students to the host institution (done by Miiia)

Am I allowed to apply?



Selection Criteria

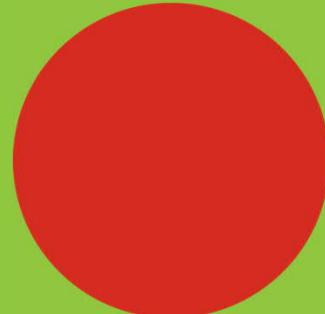
1. Minimum of one (1) year of studies completed before the student exchange (some degree programmes require 2-4 semesters before student exchange - please check the minimum requirement of your degree programme)
2. Success and progress in studies at LAB (around 60 ECTS / year).
3. Suitability of the exchange period to the student's curriculum at LAB. Exchange period needs to fit in to the normal studying time. It cannot take place during the last semester of studies.
4. Suitability of the host institution courses to the student's curriculum at LAB.
5. Sufficient knowledge to study in language of instruction based on transcript and other documents. Tested if needed.
6. Study and career related goals and motivations specified in the application.
7. Exchange takes place in a destination that genuinely supports student's internationalization (not for example in the country of residence or home country).
8. Department's approval
9. If needed, an interview.

Note! If you have problems in your life here in Finland, exchange is not a way to escape your problems → problems tend to grow and become larger in new environment!

Inclusion and accessibility

How do I start? 1/2



1. **Discuss your plans and timing for the exchange with your tutor teacher/departmental coordinator. One semester duration recommended.**
2. **Choose where you want to go, for this:**
 - Check your study field's options from the **Exchange Possibilities** portal at eLAB pages
 - Completing studies → Internationalisation and student exchange → [Exchange studies](#) → Choosing your Destination
 - Opintojen suorittaminen → Kansainvälisyminen ja opiskelijavaihio → Vaihto-opiskelu → Vaihtokohteen valinta
 - Check out the previous exchange reports – also found in the portal
 - Contact exchange students and expert students for more detailed info if possible!

How do I start? 2/2



- Host institution webpages: more detailed and up-to-date info
 - Do not start the host institution application process yet nor contact them without our permission!
- Pay attention:
 - Language (**Spain**, Italy, France, Kyoto etc)
 - Your budget (USA etc)
 - Course offering (available courses you have not done at LAB)
 - Semester timings in different countries (e.g. Germany, some Asian countries, some South American countries)
 - Housing situation (for example in Netherlands)
- Select 3 options for your application in preferred order (Electrical and Automation Engineering students: choose the 3rd one from the Mechanical Engineering's options)

3. Complete the internal application to LAB carefully

What to do if your own exact study field does not have own exchange destinations?

- Public Health Nursing -> Choose Nursing
- Industrial Mechanical Engineering -> Mechanical engineering
- Sustainable Solutions Engineering -> Energy and environmental engineering
- Industrial Information Technology -> ICT
- Sustainable Construction Technology -> Civil and construction engineering
- Kestävä kaupunkisuunnittelu -> Civil and construction engineering or Energy and environmental engineering
- Ympäristötekniologia ja kiertotalouden ratkaisut ->Energy and environmental engineering

Especially in these cases it is important to discuss with your Departmental Coordinator about the suitable destinations!

Double Degree -Two degrees in the price of one!

Needs to be carefully discussed and planned with your tutor teacher /departmental coordinator!

Double Degree possible for students in:

- ICT
- Mechanical Engineering
- Wood Technology
- International Business (also one Triple Degree possibility)
- Tourism and Hospitality (HOMA) Lappeenranta

One academic year exchange in the partner university → graduation in LAB → after that Degree certificate from the host institution

More information from your faculty and from the Exchange Possibilities portal (Program= Double Degree)

Application period also now! Make sure that you complete Double Degree application, not student exchange application!



Language competence



- It is highly recommended to learn the basics of the spoken language of the host country → it is easier to get along at the campus, everyday life and to integrate with the local people
- Benefit:
 - LAB language courses
 - open university, community college
 - self study highly recommended, mobile apps etc.
 - Erasmus+ students: Online Language Support (OLS)
- Language skills are asked in the application form → language competence is one of the selection criteria

Financing your exchange period

Think your budget already and choose affordable exchange options



- You'll get grant from LAB (=apuraha): current grant amounts informed in eLAB
 - Note! Bigger grants available usually to **European** destinations within Erasmus programme
- Student Financial Aid (=opintotuki) from KELA, if eligible
- Grants from communities, foundations or corporations (for example Otsakorpi foundation for Finnish Lappeenranta students)
 - Search and apply independently
- Special needs grant available within Erasmus+/Nordplus for student with health related special needs / disability (that causes extra costs for student during exchange). More information in: <https://elab.lab.fi/en/additional-grants>
- In Erasmus+: additional support e.g. for students with "fewer opportunities" = student has **underaged children (under 18 years)**, health obstacles, migrant background or work as caregiver (=omaishoitaja). More information in: <https://elab.lab.fi/en/additional-grants> .
- **Your own savings**
- Note that you might need document of sufficient funds later on for **visa application** (if visa is required) or for the **host institution** (for example host institutions in USA).



EXCHANGE APPLICATION PROCESS



Student Exchange process

1. Application to the home institution (LAB) by 29.1.2026
→ wait for the internal acceptance – via email by mid March
2. Mandatory Go Abroad Kick Off I via Zoom
In late March OR September **depending on your exchange period timing**. Invitations will be sent later.
3. Application to the host institution
→ official acceptance
4. Mandatory Go Abroad Kick Off II via Zoom
In late April or November depending on your exchange period timing. Invitations will be sent later.
5. Your exchange period
6. Returning back home – documents and report
7. Participation in marketing in different events, fairs as an expert student

Application to home institution (LAB)



- You'll find the instructions for exchange process in [eLAB](#)
- Select three options for the application (In Double Degree just one is enough) / check available places in portal!
- Online application (LAB Mobility-Online system) link available at eLAB during the application period – after sending the application form, follow instructions received via email
- Finish all application steps by the deadline 29.1. (no changes after submitting the application!)
- Only one application / application round

Internal acceptance

- Faculty Departmental coordinators together with the International Mobility Services will make the selections according to the selection criteria
- *If needed – invitations for interviews*
- Acceptances will be made by mid March

→ After acceptance (and nomination) you can apply to **the host institution you have been accepted to!** Read carefully the acceptance email! Do not contact the host institution before this!

This is official application process that you need to commit to! Inform me immediately if you need to cancel (only for valid reason) etc.

Mobility-Online Application Form 1/2

- Select the correct application form (Student exchange or Double Degree application)
- Answer to the questions with thorough replies
- If you are applying to destination that provides several minors/programmes, specify the minor/program that you would choose. In case you want to complete placement in host institution (Health and Social Welfare Unit- students), specify what kind of placement, how many ECTS etc.
- Relevant language skills are asked in the online application – be honest!
- Inform if you have been in Erasmus exchange before
- ?-icon provides further help text
- You need to fill out the application form from up to bottom

Note that it is an official application form!

Note! After sending the online application form the **application process still continues**:

Follow the instructions that you receive by email – carefully!

Documents that need to be uploaded

1. Photograph of your face (does **not** need to be an official one), max. 500 x 500 pxl.
2. CV (in English)
3. Transcript of records (opintosuoritusote), **your own printed version from Peppi (Atomii) is enough**.

→ **Submit your application** via workflow link "Submit application"

- You confirm that the application is complete and all information is correct and up-to-date
- You cannot edit your application after this is done!
- Needs to be completed latest on 29.1.

LAB Mobility-Online System

- Once you have submitted your online application form (link available at eLAB during the application period), you can enter the system /your application:
 - via direct link received by email
 - link available from eLAB (Note not make new application!)
- Log in to your application by using HAKA (click HAKA logo and enter your LAB ID), no separate user name for LAB Mobility-Online
- If password problems, you need to follow IT instructions for LAB ID password change
- Problems with Mobility-Online system? Contact only outgoing@lab.fi and specify your problem carefully, add screenshots if possible
- Host institution might use Mobility-Online aswell, but your information does not transfer.** Both processes are separate and need to be completed.

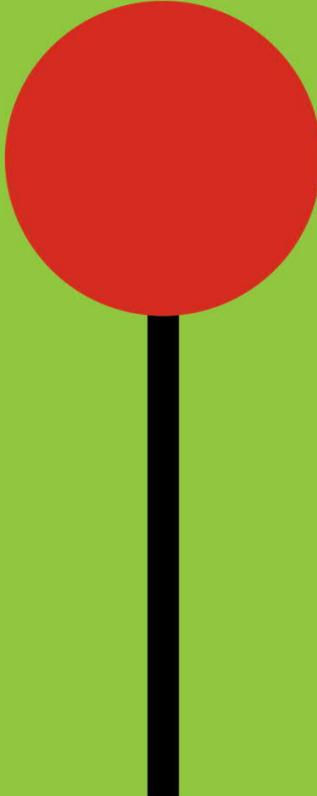

THINGS TO NOTE

Note! (1/2)



- Make sure that you have valid email address that you are using **actively** in Mobility-Online system (check SPAM folders also actively!)
- If you are filling out the online application form together with your friend, make sure you have logged in to computer/in the systems only via your own LAB ID and delete all browsing history (internet options) before starting the application form (this way your HAKA identification won't be mixed)
- Exchange programmes have some own requirements – e.g. Erasmus studies/placement possible for max 12 months / degree level
- Check that you have valid passport and it will be valid for the whole exchange period (and possible extra time if visa needed). **Passport number needed in some host institution application form** (e.g. South Korea) so check already the validity of your passport!
- Green Travel is supported, learn more and get tips from [Sustainability on exchange period](#)
- **Once exchange has been accepted at LAB, no cancellations!**





Note! (2/2)

Design and Fine Arts students:

- Portfolio is usually needed to the **host** institution application. Start preparing your portfolio and get your tutor teacher's approval for it before applying to the host institution (portfolio is not needed for the LAB internal application yet). **Note that rejection from the host institution is possible – realize the importance of the quality of your portfolio!**
- Application is sent to only one host institution at a time. If you'll get rejected please contact me immediately – I can check if there still are some options available.

Social and Health Care students:

- if completing only placement **via partner school**: make student exchange application normally, grant= student exchange grant. Note that placement options will be confirmed later on in the process (they vary from year to year). Partner institutions might not offer exactly the placements you wish for. **Join the Moodle course for your faculty's students to get more info!**

Master students: exchange possibility needs to be checked/confirmed individually from the host institution. Late confirmation possible, be prepared for sudden changes.
