Financial support (minimum 941 €)

- 79 €/day (also from travelling days)
($6 \times 79 \text{ €} = 474 \text{ €}$ +travelling days $2 \times 79 \text{ €} = 158 \text{ €}$ total sum 632 €)
- Travel support (~1300 km, straight distance one-way) 309 €
 - Also if you travel "green" the funding is 417 €.
 - Also extra travel days possible (79 € per day, max 6 days)

- If you have some reasons to receive inclusion support, you can receive 100 € extra support.

How to Apply (reserve places)

- For this application you can apply for reserve places
- Criteria who can apply (you need minimum 60 ECTS passed studies to apply.)
- If you have been to exchange via Erasmus in Fall you cannot apply (or received financial support from Erasmus-program)
 - Selection is based:
 - the study success (The more studies you have)
 - The study grades (your Grade Point Average)
